- When the object we are talking about starts with a vowel (ex: **a**nt, **o**ctopus, **e**lephant) we use "an".

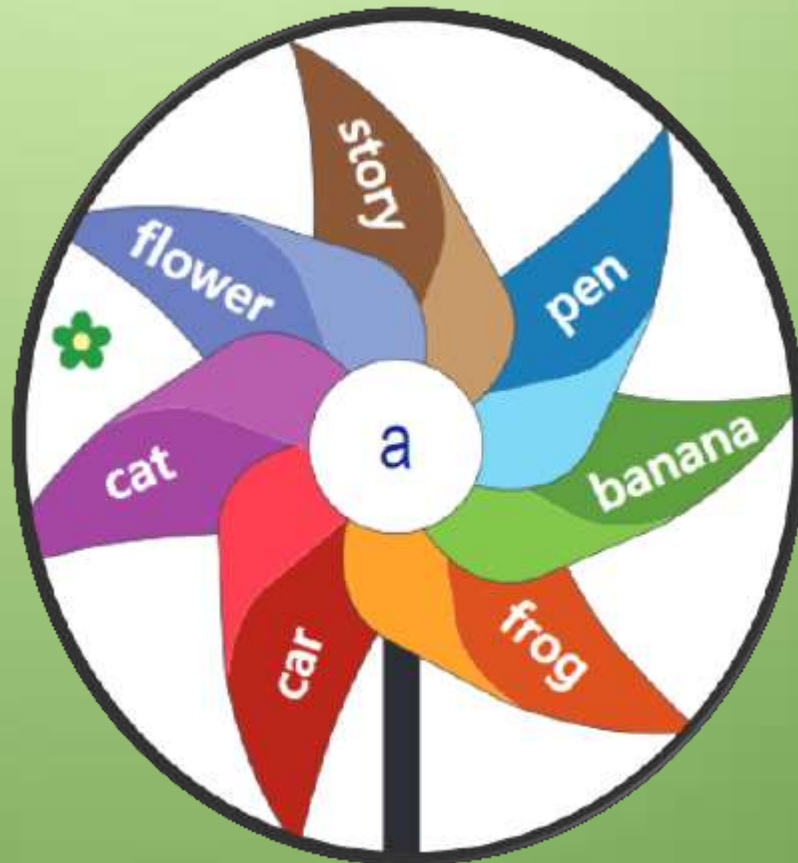
