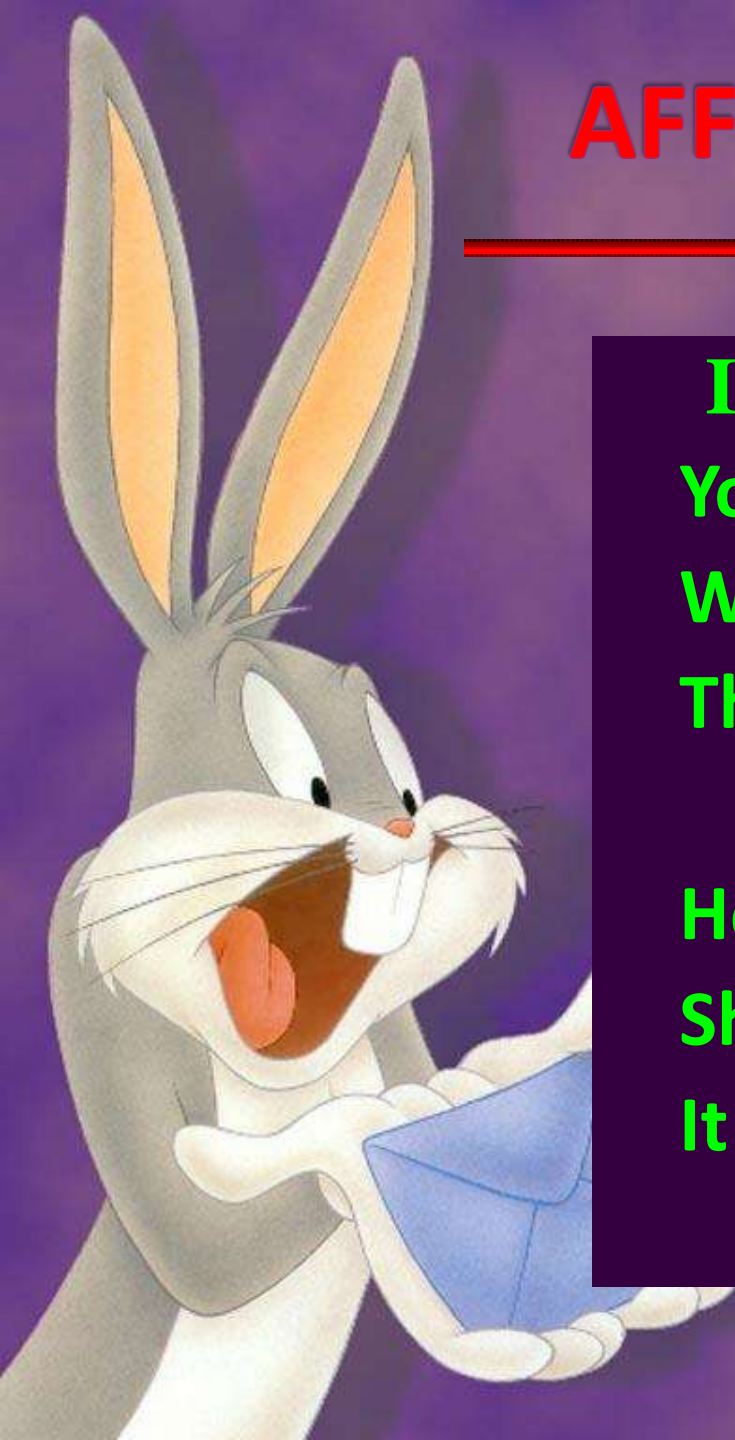

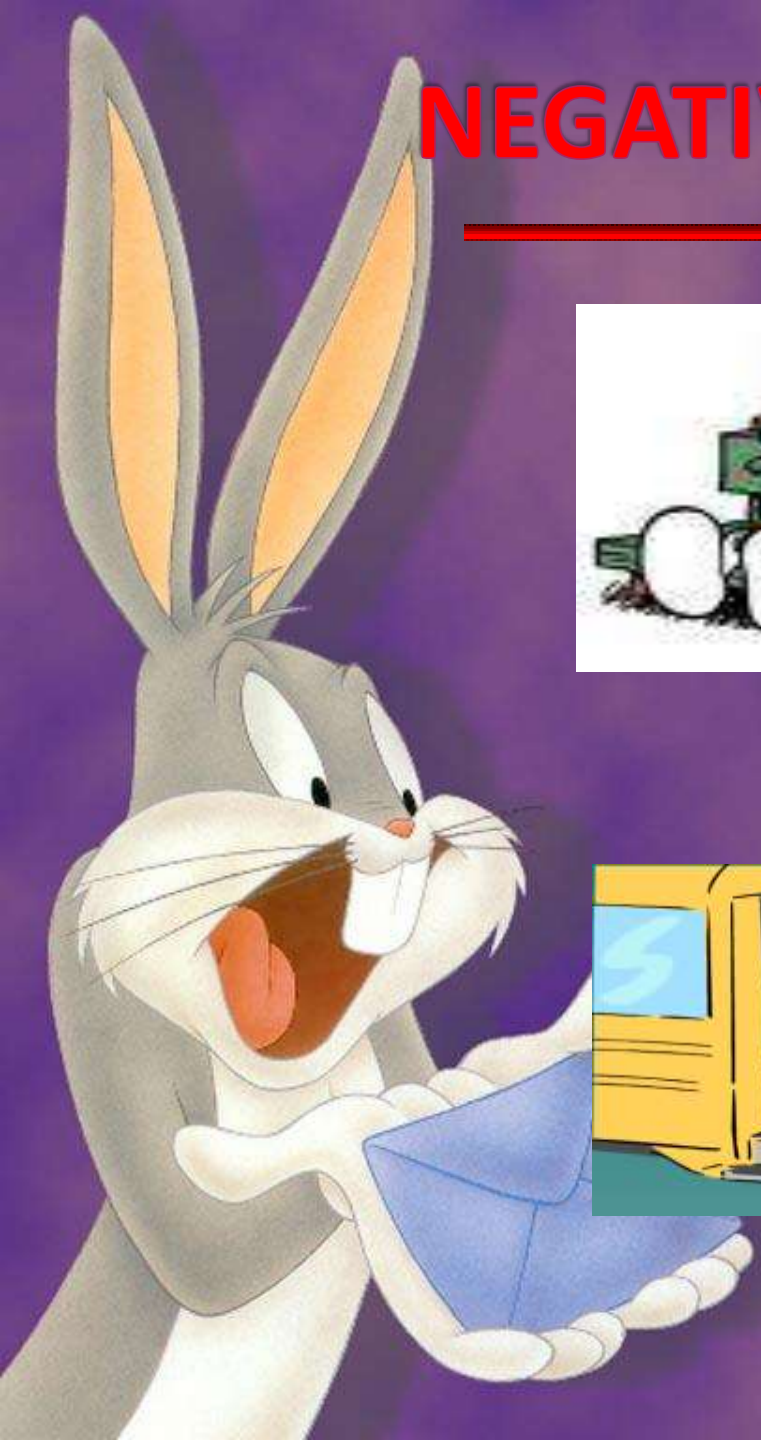

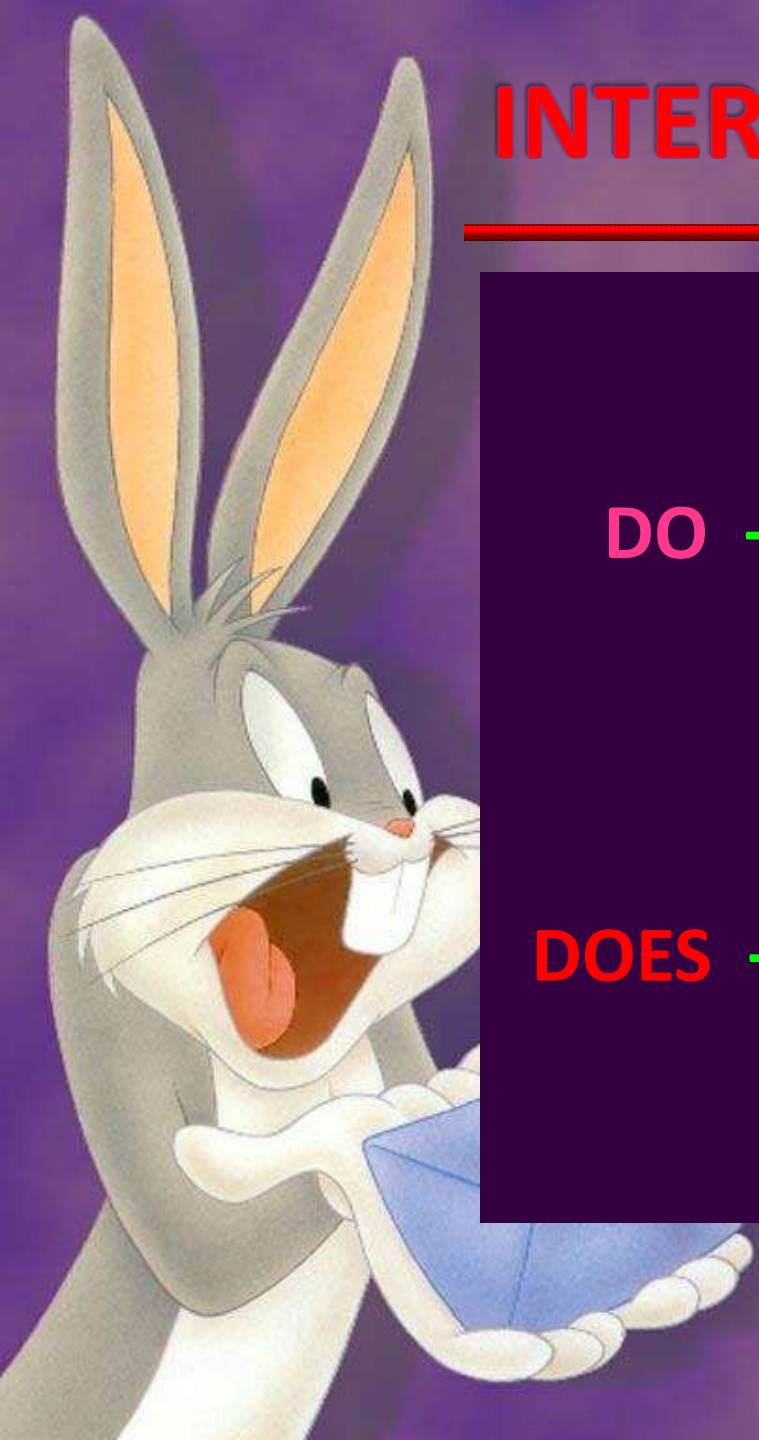

INTERROGATIVE FORM



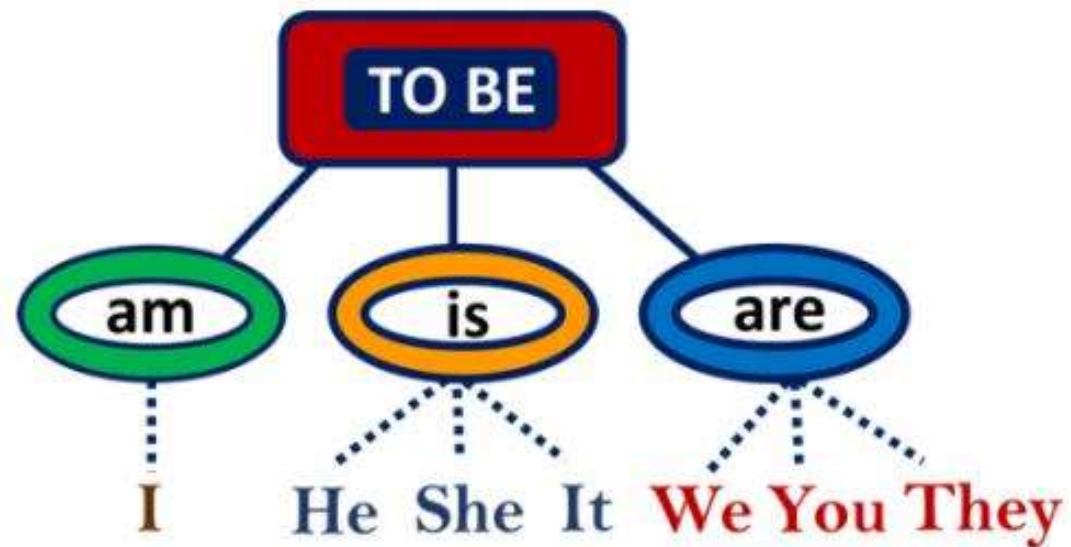
-Do they like cookies?
