We can change the order of the past progressive actions without changing the meaning.

### Past progressive and simple past + when / while

I saw him downtown while I was walking to the dentist. While I was walking to the dentist, I saw him downtown.

We often use the past progressive and the simple past in the same sentence.

- The <sup>1</sup> past progressive / simple past describes a longer action in progress when the shorter <sup>2</sup> past progressive / simple past action happened.
- We connect the actions with when or while. When usually precedes the <sup>3</sup> past progressive / simple past, and while usually precedes the <sup>4</sup>past progressive / simple past.


