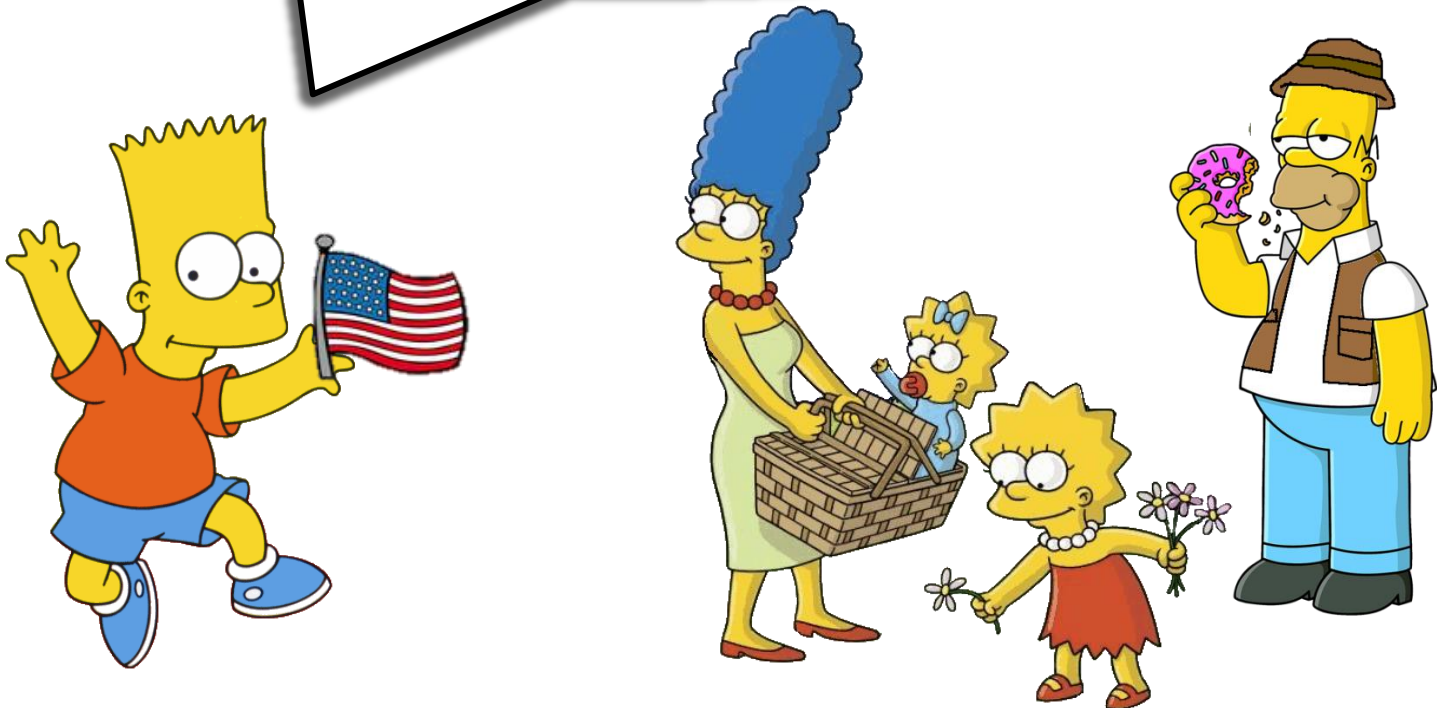


Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

Verb TO Be

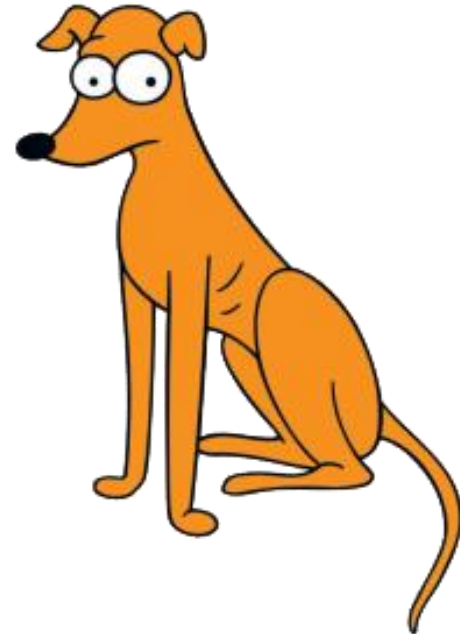
AFFIRMATIVE

You and your friends

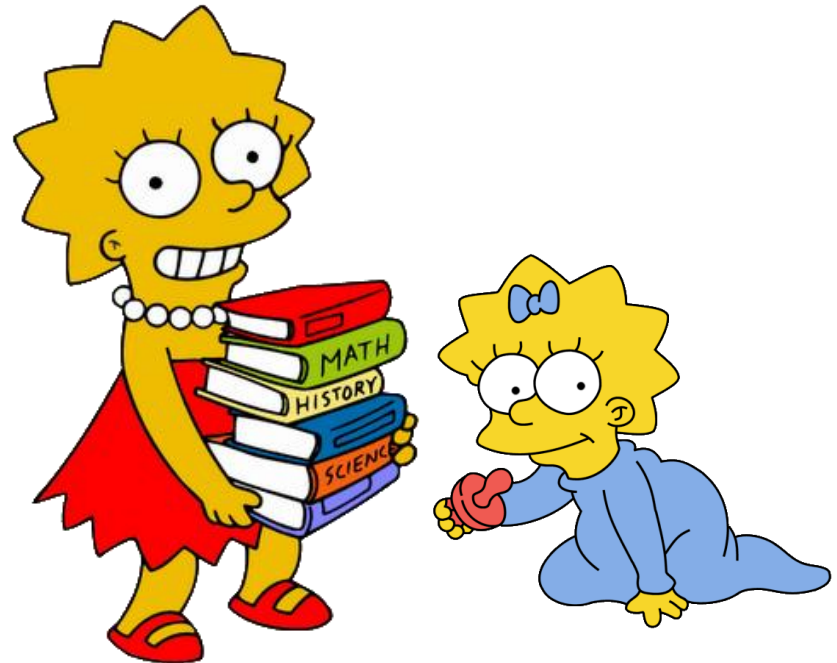
are students.

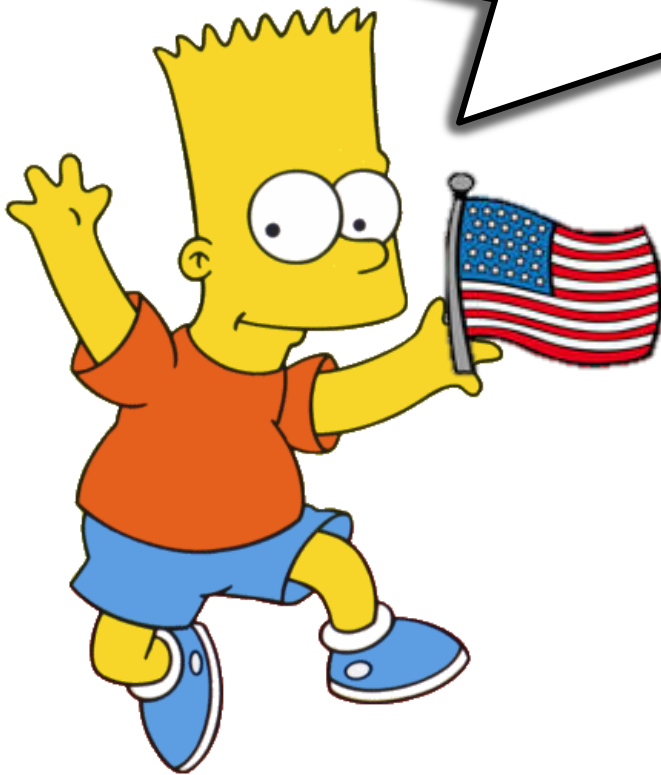


Verb TO Be

She **is not** Marge.
She **isn't** my mom.



Verb TO Be NEGATIVE

We **are not** from Mexico.

We **aren't** Mexican.



Verb TO BE NEGATIVE

I'm not
You aren't
He isn't
She isn't
It isn't
We aren't
You aren't
They aren't

Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

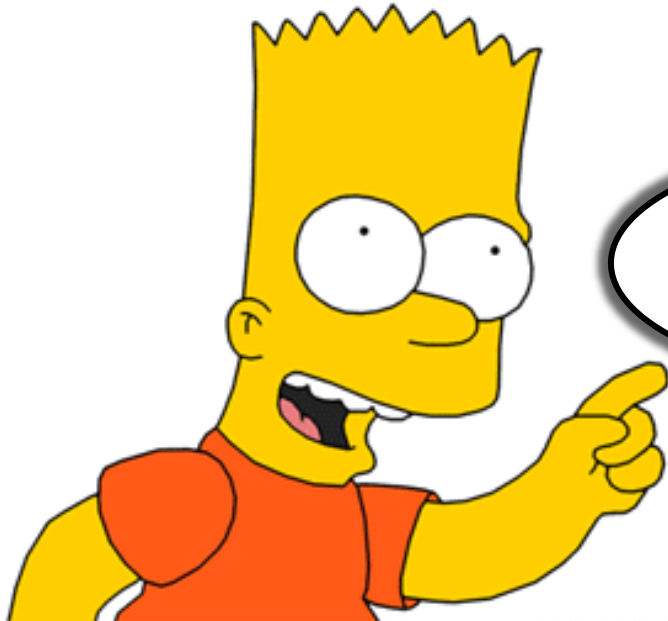
Am I your best friend?

Yes, **I am.**

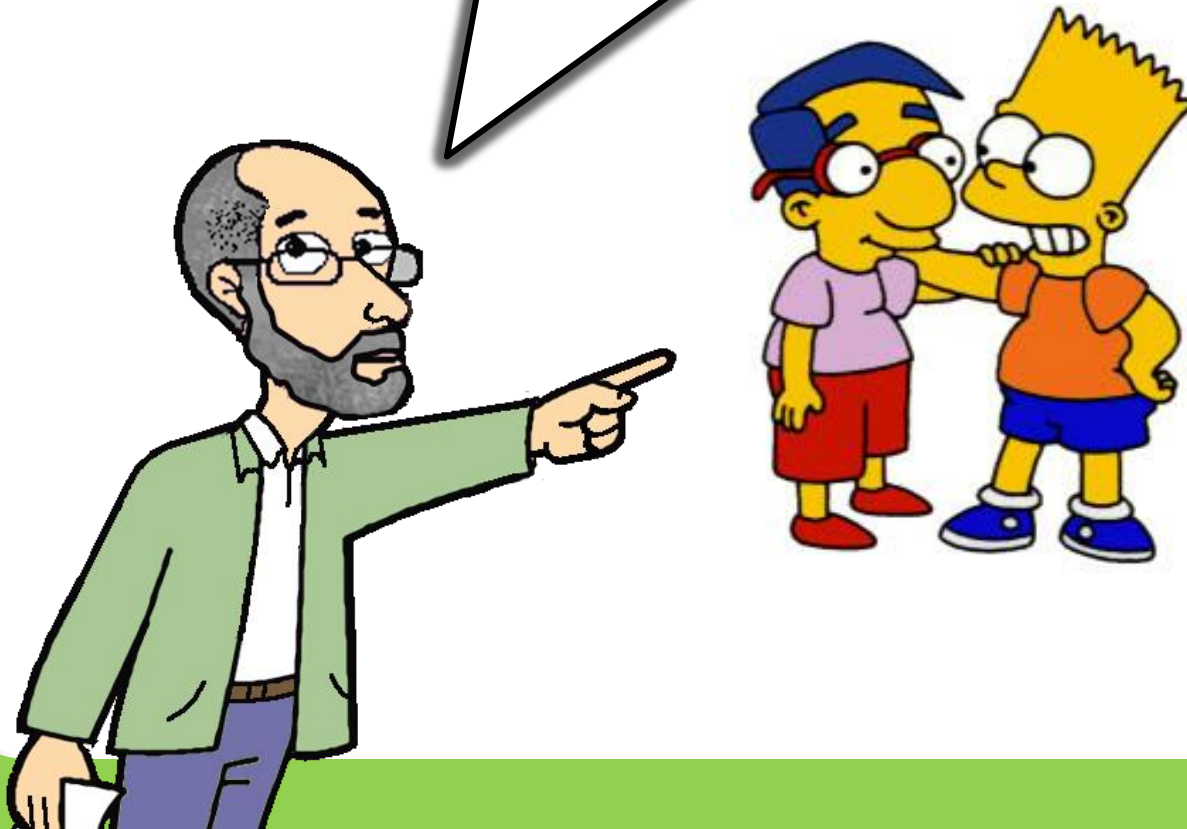
